and made it off the ground This first flight lasted just 12 seconds, and the plane flew only 120 feet...but history had been made The brothers took turns and made three more flights that day The longest, with Wilbur at the controls, was 852 feet and lasted 59 seconds After that last flight, a strong gust of wind destroyed the airplane
